## Directions:

- 1. Print game board and game pieces.
- 2. Glue the game board on the inside of a manila folder so it's sturdy and durable.
- 3. Cut out heart below and glue in the top center of the game board, connecting the two sides of the game board heart.
- 4. Decorate, decorate, decorate the board with all things fabulous, shiny, fancy, and beautiful!
- 5. Write uppercase and lowercase letters that your child needs to work on in each of the boxes. (Usually 2-4 letter sounds works best, two sounds that are difficult and two that she knows well.)
- 6. Find images or objects that begin with those letters, and put them on index cards or (if they're objects) into a bag. It's okay if you don't have enough—you can use the same ones twice and/or re-shuffle after you've gone through them once.
- 7. Find game pieces—a Foamie, a tiny doll, a piece of jewelry, a bead—anything works, and place them on the 'Start' heart.
- 8. Player one chooses a card/ object, says the object out loud and isolates the sound it begins with. The player moves her game piece to the first square with the letter that makes that sound.
- 9. The winner is the first to make it to the 'Finish' heart!

\*This is a low-stress, fun learning game, so make up the rules as you go!
